The college is situated in central part of tribal district and out of its total number of students almost 45% of the students belongs to SC and ST. For them earning their livelihood by themselves and simultaneously taking education is a highly challenging task. So in the first year of graduation we observe a higher drop-out ratio indicating the internal conflict and strife of the students in his/her life trying to gain education and earn livelihood simultaneously, where in quite a number of students fail to do both the activities.

Geographically Dahod district is a dry region with scanty rainfall. This compels the students to earn livelihood by migrating at distant places who are then unable to cope up with the academic momentum. However, we have marked that those who are able to fight in their internal conflict of continuing the study are then successful in completing Second and Third year of their bachelor degree program. Dropout ratio reduces drastically in Second and Third year of the Degree Program.
